TULARE COUNTY SUPERIOR COURT APPOINTS JENNIFER FULTZ AS SMALL CLAIMS/TRAFFIC COMMISSIONER

The Tulare County Superior Court has announced Jennifer Fultz was selected as Tulare County's newest Commissioner.

Commissioner Fultz was appointed following a recruitment and interview process. Fultz will preside over the court's Small Claims and Traffic matters in both the Visalia and South County locations. "Jennifer's years as a Senior Deputy District Attorney have uniquely prepared her to serve in this new capacity. She has many years of courtroom and public service experience that will help her transition nicely into the role of judicial officer" said Court Executive Officer, Stephanie Cameron.

Fultz has over 20 years of public sector experience, serving as a Deputy District Attorney since moving to the area in 2004. She attended UCLA earning a bachelor's degree in applied mathematics and her law degree at Santa Clara University School of Law. Fultz is active in the community having served as a past president of the Board of Directors for the Sequoia Symphony Orchestra. She is married to the Honorable Anthony Fultz and together they have two children.

Commissioners are subordinate judicial officers employed by the court to hear matters as assigned pursuant to statute or stipulation. Fultz fills a vacancy anticipated by the upcoming retirement of Commissioner David S. Wooten, who served in the role for 27 years.
